Narrative

At Collins Memorial Library at the University of Puget Sound, an urgent mission unfolds. As they go about their daily tasks, a cryptic message suddenly appears on their secured devices from their handler, known only as **the Archivist**. A wave of high-profile crimes has struck libraries and archives worldwide. Each responsible for theft, sabotage, and disruption on an international scale.

By sharing knowledge, collaborating under pressure, and supporting each other's strengths, you can rescue the missing librarians, liberate our fellow agents in the library consortium, and bring members of **POISON** to justice.

The clock is ticking. The world is watching. Gather your courage, rally your teammates, and prepare to secure the future of libraries everywhere. Failure is not an option.
